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INITIAL SETUP

Prepare to embark on an exciting journey with your Vavus 2 Intelligent Translator! This user manual is here to guide you through every step, making sure you have the best experience possible.

Initial setup is required when you turn on the unit for the first time.

POWER ON/OFF MAGIC

Navigate your Vavus 2 effortlessly:

- A long press of the power button ignites your device.

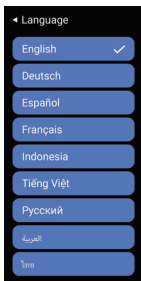
Hold down the power button placed on the left top side of the device.



LANGUAGE OF CHOICE

During setup, handpick your preferred language. Your conversations are about to transcend boundaries!

Select the language that will be displayed in. Tap [Next].



NOTE:

Your device settings and explanations will be displayed in this language.

EMBRACE CONNECTIVITY

Seamlessly connect to Wi-Fi: Explore networks and find yours. Prepare for endless connectivity.

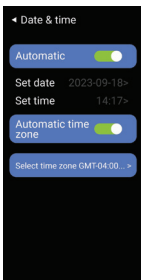
Switch [Wi-Fi] to [ON] - Blue, tap the network name you want to connect to and enter the password. Click [Confirm] to connect. Ensure internet connectivity for optimal usage.



TIME FOR ADVENTURE

Time management made simple: opt for automatic time setup or adjust manually. Stay in sync with the world around you.

In order to ensure accurate functionality, it is important to configure the device with the appropriate date and time based on the designated time zone. The "Automatic" option automatically adjusts the time and zone.



CONNECT THE DEVICE TO THE MOBILE DATA VIA SIM CARD

How to Insert a SIM Card into Your Device

1. Locate the SIM Card Slot:

-Look on the left side of the device for a SIM Card tray accompanied by a small hole. · This hole serves as the entry point to the SIM card tray.

2.Prepare the SIM Card Pin:

-In your device's box, you should find a small metal tool known as a SIM card pin or ejector tool.
-If you don't have one, a small paperclip can also work in a pinch.

3.Eject the SIM Card Tray:

-Gently insert the SIM card pin or the end of the paperclip into the small hole.
-Apply a bit of pressure until the tray pops out slightly.
-Carefully pull out the tray the rest of the way with your fingers.

4.Place the SIM Card on the Tray:

-Notice the cut corner on your SIM card. This will help you align it correctly.
-Lay the SIM card on the tray, ensuring it fits snugly and the cut corner matches the tray's shape.

5.Insert the Tray Back into the Device:

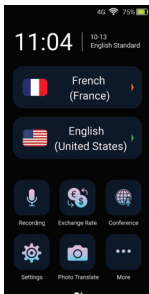
-Carefully slide the tray (with the SIM card on it) back into the slot.
-Ensure you're inserting it the right way – it should go in smoothly without any resistance.

6.Power On and Check:

-Turn on your device.
-If inserted correctly, your device should detect the SIM card, and you'll see signal bars on the top corner of the screen.

When the initial setup is finished, the home screen should appear.

CHARGING

Charge using the included USB wall adapter and USB cable.



TURNING THE DEVICE ON/OFF

Long press the power button on the device's left top side to turn it on/off.



Short press for lock/unlock the screen

While on, long press for power off/restart options

BASIC OPERATIONS

The unit features a touch display. This User Manual uses the following terms to describe operations.

TAP

Touching the screen with your fingertip is called a "tap", which is a commonly used operation. Touching the screen and keeping your finger in place is called "tap and hold".

SCROLL

Swiping repeatedly to view other parts in the screen such as lists is called "scroll".

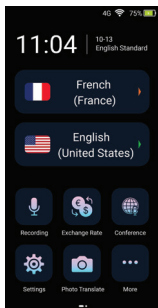
SWIPE

Dragging your fingertip on the screen in one direction is called a "swipe".

USING VAVUS 2

MASTERING LANGUAGE TRANSLATION

Select source and target languages on the main screen.



CONVERSATIONS, CAPTURED

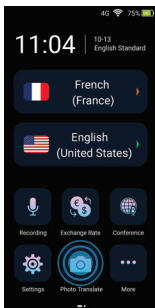
Enter voice recognition mode by pressing Orange/Green buttons. Release to automatically recognize and translate speech. Saved recordings can be played back later.



PHOTOS SPEAK VOLUMES

Access the Photo Translation feature from the main menu.

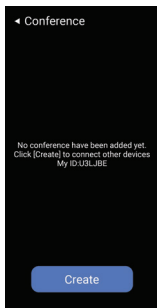
Point the device at the text and tap the camera icon at the bottom of the screen. The device will take a photo and begin scanning. At the top, choose whether to translate the text on the photo or the recognized text within the image.



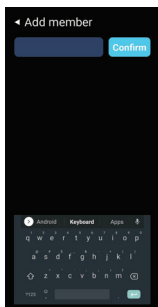
EMBRACE GLOBAL CONNECTIONS

Join the conversation everywhere:
Create or join a group chat/conference for multi-person translation.

Start by tapping the 'Conference' app icon on the main screen. To join an existing conference, share your ID with the host, or tap 'Create' to initiate a new one.



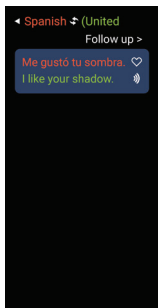
To access the conference menu, tap the three lines at the top right of screen. In the menu you can add or remove members, select language or adjust conference settings. Remember, any conference participant can add or remove members. To leave the conference, Access Member management from the menu.



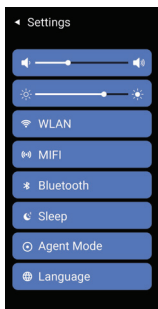
In 'Advanced Settings', you can enable 'Auto Play' to hear translations aloud or activate 'Shield Message' to prevent new messages from appearing.

CHECK THE TRANSLATION RESULT

Your spoken words and the translation result will be displayed on the screen as text, and the translation result will be played back as speech. By typing on the result, you can listen to it again.

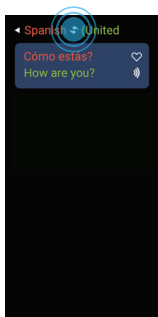


To modify the volume and brightness, navigate to Settings. Press and hold the circle on the sliders, then move it left or right to make adjustments.



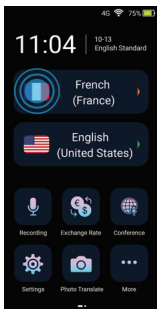
CHANGING THE TRANSLATION DIRECTION

The paired translation languages are shown at the top of the screen. Simply tap the arrow between them to swap the languages.

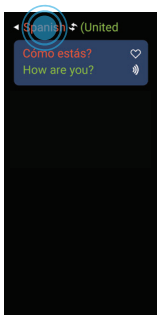


CHANGING THE TRANSLATION LANGUAGE

On the main screen, tap the language you want to change, and the list of languages will pop-up. Tap on the desired language.



You can also change the language during the translation by tapping on the language that you want to change at the top of the screen. The list of languages will pop up.



REVIEWING THE TRANSLATION HISTORY

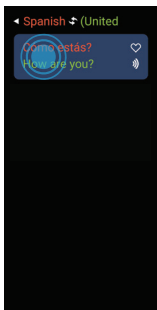
To review previous translations, enter the translation chat by pressing any translation button or swiping to the right. Tap any entry to play it out loud.

FAVORITES

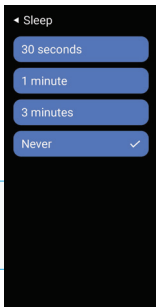
To add a translation to the favorites, tap on the heart on the translation. Favorites added from the translation history will be displayed here. Tap the phrase you would like to review. This will playback the phrase. By long tapping you can remove the unwanted favorite.

DELETING PREVIOUS TRANSLATIONS

By tapping on the text on the screen, you will be prompted a dropdown menu from where you can choose to [Delete] the translation or [Clear the translation history].



STATUS ICONS:



To lock/unlock the screen, press the power button. To set or change the auto-lock timer, go to settings -> Sleep and select the desired duration.

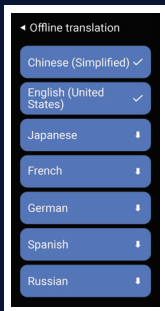
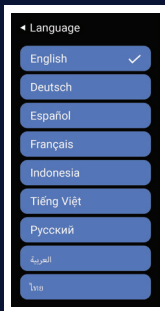

OFFLINE TRANSLATION:

ENJOY OFFLINE TRANSLATION IN 13 LANGUAGES, ENSURING COMMUNICATION KNOWS NO BOUNDARIES.

TO ACCESS THE OFFLINE TRANSLATION FEATURE, DOWNLOAD THE DESIRED LANGUAGE FROM SETTINGS -> OFFLINE PACKAGE MANAGEMENT AND TAP ON THE ARROW NEXT TO THE LANGUAGE. THE DOWNLOAD WILL START, AND A CHECKMARK WILL APPEAR ONCE THE DOWNLOAD IS COMPLETE.

LONG PRESS THE ORANGE/GREEN BUTTON ON THE DEVICE TO TRIGGER THE SPEECH- RECOGNITION MODE. AFTER RELEASING THE ORANGE/GREEN BUTTON, THE SPEECH WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY RECOGNIZED AND TRANSLATED TO THE SPECIFIED TARGET LANGUAGE.





RECORDING

RECORD IN ENGLISH, MANDARIN AND CANTONESE AND TRANSLATE DIRECTLY IN THE LANGUAGE DESIRED WITHOUT THE NEED OR LONG PRESSING THE TRANSLATION BUTTON. SAVE AND USE THE RECORDING FOR LATER.

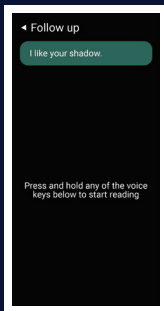


PHOTO TRANSLATION

INPUT TRANSLATION

IN THE MAIN MENU, SELECT "INPUT TRANSLATION". TAP ON "ENTER TEXT HERE" TO BRING UP THE KEYBOARD. AFTER TYPING, TAP 'OK' TO GET THE TRANSLATION.



EXCHANGE RATE

IN THE MAIN MENU, TAP "MORE" AND SELECT THE EXCHANGE RATE APP. CHOOSE YOUR DESIRED CURRENCIES BY TAPPING THE RED AND BLUE RECTANGLES. ENTER THE AMOUNT AND HIT 'CONVERT'. THE RESULT WILL BE DISPLAYED BELOW. IF YOU NEED ADDITIONAL CURRENCIES NOT LISTED, PLEASE REACH OUT TO US.



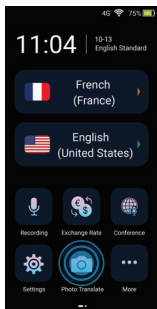
UNIT CONVERSION

IN THE MAIN MENU, TAP "MORE" AND SELECT THE UNIT CONVERSION APP. CHOOSE FROM LENGTH, VOLUME, WEIGHT, OR TEMPERATURE. THEN, PICK THE UNITS YOU WISH TO CONVERT FROM AND TO. ENTER THE QUANTITY AND PRESS 'CONVERT'. THE CONVERTED VALUE WILL DISPLAY BELOW. IF A SPECIFIC UNIT YOU NEED ISN'T LISTED, PLEASE CONTACT US.

PHOTO TRANSLATION

Translate text effortlessly from sources like city signs, books, and restaurant menus.

- Open the photo translation app from the menu.
- Before pointing the camera at the text, choose the source and target languages at the top of the screen.



TRANSLATING A PHOTO

- Capture the text by aiming your camera at it.
- Tap the screen to focus on the desired text, then press the Photo button located at the screen's bottom.
- Once captured, the AI will begin analyzing the image. A preview of the detected text will then appear.
- Choose between translating the text directly or overlaying the translation on the image.

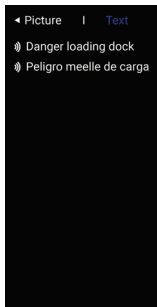


PHOTO TRANSLATION FEATURES AND TIPS

- **History Preservation:** The device retains and stores past entries, keeping them until manually deleted.
- **Multilingual Support:** Vavus 2's photo translation capability supports 43 languages, offering a fresh perspective to comprehend your surroundings.
- **Audio Playback:** By tapping the speaker icon, you can listen to the source text.
- **Image History:** To view previously captured images, tap the image icon located next to the capture button.
- **Exiting Translation:** Once done with your translation, press the blue circle at the bottom of the device to close the translation result.

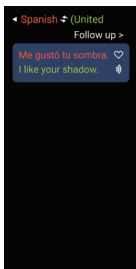
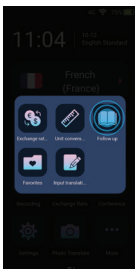
SPEAKING SKILLS ENHANCEMENT FEATURE

Purpose: This feature focuses on honing your speaking abilities in a foreign language. It aids in practicing pronunciation and fine-tuning accents.

Method: Engage in active listening of translations and participate in exercises designed to boost effective verbal communication.

How to Use:

- Navigate to the main menu and tap "more".
- Select the "follow-up" app.
- Choose your preferred languages at the top.
- Utilize the orange and green buttons for translation.
- Tap "follow-up".
- To begin reading, press and hold any of the voice keys.
- Upon completion, your performance result and score will appear.
- To practice again, simply click and repeat the process.



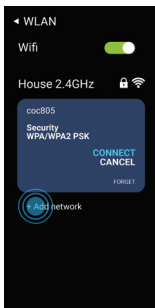
WI-FI AND MIFI SETUP GUIDE

SETTING UP WI-FI:

- Go to "Settings" and tap on "WLAN".
- Select your preferred Wi-Fi connection.
- Enter the required password to connect.

CONNECTING TO A HIDDEN WI-FI NETWORK:

- Tap on "[Add Network]" located at the screen's bottom.
- Provide the necessary details: Network name, Security type, Password
- If you need more information or face any issues, please contact your network administrator.



About MiFi:

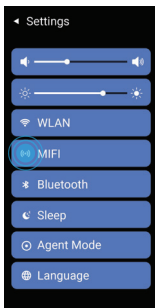
MiFi allows Vavus to act as a Wi-Fi hotspot, enabling other devices to connect to Vavus' internet.

SIM Card Compatibility:

The Vavus SIM Card isn't compatible with the hotspot feature. A separate SIM card is needed to utilize the hotspot.

Activation:

- Navigate to "Settings" and select "MiFi".
- Toggle the switch to turn it on (it will turn green when activated).
- Tap "name" if you wish to rename the device's hotspot.
- Tap "password" to modify the access password for added security.



BLUETOOTH CONNECTION GUIDE

CONNECTING TO BLUETOOTH DEVICES:

- Navigate to "Settings" and choose "Bluetooth".
- Toggle the switch to activate it (it will turn green when on).
- Browse and select the device you wish to connect with from the available list.

UNPAIRING DEVICES:

- In the "List of paired devices", tap and hold the device you intend to unpair.
- A pop-up will appear; select "forget" to unpair the device.

Purpose: Use Agent Mode for enhanced performance on networks with slower speeds

Steps:

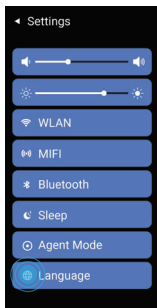
- Navigate to "Settings".

MOBILE NETWORK CONFIGURATION GUIDE

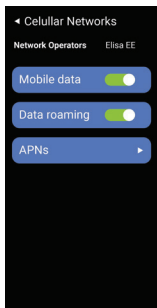
Enable or disable cellular data.

TROUBLESHOOTING

1. Device Doesn't Power On:

- Ensure the battery is charged.
- Check if the charger and cable are working properly with other devices.
- Perform a hard reset by long pressing the power button for at least 10 seconds.

2. Translation is Inaccurate:

- Ensure the device's software/firmware is updated.
- Check if the correct source and target languages are selected.
- Speak clearly and slowly, ensuring there's minimal background noise.

3. Device Doesn't Recognize Speech:

- Ensure the microphone is not obstructed or dirty.
- Restart the device.
- Reset the device.

4. Connectivity Issues:

- Ensure Wi-Fi or cellular data is active and stable
- Forget and reconnect to the network
- Make sure the SIM Card is activated
- Restart or Reset the Device

5. Screen Issues:

- Adjust brightness settings.
- If the touchscreen is unresponsive, try restarting the device.
- Check for any physical damage.

6. Audio Issues:

- Adjust volume settings.
- Ensure the speaker is not obstructed or dirty.
- Test with headphones to see if the issue is with the device's speaker.

7. Device Overheating:

- Avoid using the device under direct sunlight for extended periods.
- Ensure the device has adequate ventilation.

1. Does the device work offline or require internet?

Yes, the device works offline. You would need to download the language from settings, then use the offline translate app. Unfortunately, some features like photo translation will require an internet connection. The device has 13 languages offered offline, and the SIM card is not needed for these languages. But you do need internet to download the offline language into the device.

2. What languages does the device support?

The device supports numerous languages for online translation, including but not limited to Chinese, English (US), Japanese, French, Spanish, Russian, Korean, Arabic variants, and many more. For offline translation, it supports languages like Chinese (Simplified), English (US), Japanese, French, German, Spanish, Russian, Korean, Portuguese, Dutch, and Italian. The device translates various languages from India like Hindi, Malayalam, Telugu, Bengali, Tamil, Urdu, and Marathi, but doesn't translate Gujarati yet. It also translates Filipino Cebuano, but not Tagalog. The device doesn't support Albanian, Yoruba, Igbo, and Hausa.

3. What is the role of the SIM card in the device?

The Vavus Sim Card offers complimentary data valid for a minimum of two years. Activation is straightforward with instructions provided in the package. The activation process is typically swift, often taking under a minute. However, occasional delays might occur due to the service provider. Go to www.shopvavus.com/activatesim for more information.

4. How does the photo translation feature work?

The photo translation feature requires an internet connection, and you can only use photo translation if you're online. Refer to the Photo Translation page in the user manual.

5. How does the device handle translations during conversations or presentations?

The Green and Oranges buttons are used for two-way translation. Pressing "Orange" translates from the first language to the second and pressing "Green" does the reverse. For real-time continuous translations like TV shows, there is the recording function for English and Mandarin.

6. Are there any plans for future updates or languages?

We consistently add new languages both offline and online.

7. What about charging outside the US?

For charging outside the US, the device comes with a wall adapter that you can plug into an international adapter.
